



Since its founding in 1987, the Parma Hospital Health Care Foundation has provided more than **\$ 4.2 million** of philanthropic support of Parma Hospital's mission, expanding its services and its medical, health and wellness care outreach in the community.



The Foundation raised **\$300,000** to help create the **Tri-C Nursing School at Parma Hospital**. The school has helped several Parma Hospital employees realize their dream of becoming registered nurses while at the same time easing the Hospital's nursing shortage and strengthening its nursing process.



\$2.5 million built the **Seasons of Life Residential Hospice**, an expansion of the Home Hospice program in order to provide high quality end of life care. Since its opening, Seasons of Life has gently cared for thousands of people and has built an excellent reputation and deep community support.



More than **\$ 205,000** has supported the growth and development of programs at the ElderCenter including medically supported adult day services, The Club weekly retreat for active adults experiencing memory loss and Club Soda, serving adults ages 21-49 with structured opportunities and development. These programs are increasingly important for the community's ageing population.

A Caring Partnership



The Parma Health Ministry provides medical care for working uninsured persons thanks to the generosity and compassion of Parma Hospital physicians. The Foundation is proud to provide operations support of the ministry office while Parma Hospital provides clinical services for ministry patients including most surgeries, inpatient stays, outpatient procedures and ancillary testing such as laboratory and radiology.

The Foundation also supports these programs and more.

- **Medical care for the working, uninsured** through the Parma Health Ministry and other organizations
- **Patient Care Support** in several Parma Hospital departments
- **Health Education programs** for adults and children in the Parma Hospital service area
- **Safety net programs** in the Parma Hospital service area such as hunger relief and care for the disabled
